

The Egg Game

Event: Various
Theme: N/A
Preparation Time: 15-20 minutes
Running Time: 20-30 minutes
Materials: Eggs & Boxes – Half dozen per team
Coloured Markers

Preparation: For each box of eggs, various points need to be assigned to the eggs by labelling them with the coloured markers, e.g. 3 five point eggs, 2 ten point eggs and 1 twenty point egg. These eggs then need to be scattered around the playing area, either openly or well hidden. You will need to keep the boxes at base or assign a “box keeper”

Playing The Game: Version 1:
Each team simply has to go out and find their coloured eggs and return them safely to their box to score points. Any damaged eggs will not be counted.

Version 2:
Version 1 can lend itself to “accidental breakage” of other team’s eggs. Therefore, this can be turned into a ruthless, but fun, alternative by designating a “destroyer”. If an egg is found that does not belong to the team that found it, it can be taken to the “destroyer” and be officially destroyed.

Notes: If you wish to play this game multiple times, golf balls or similar can be used rather than eggs. However, the destroying element seems to appeal to Cubs for some reason...
Naturally, the game can be made harder by having multiple box keepers that are also roaming the playing area.
