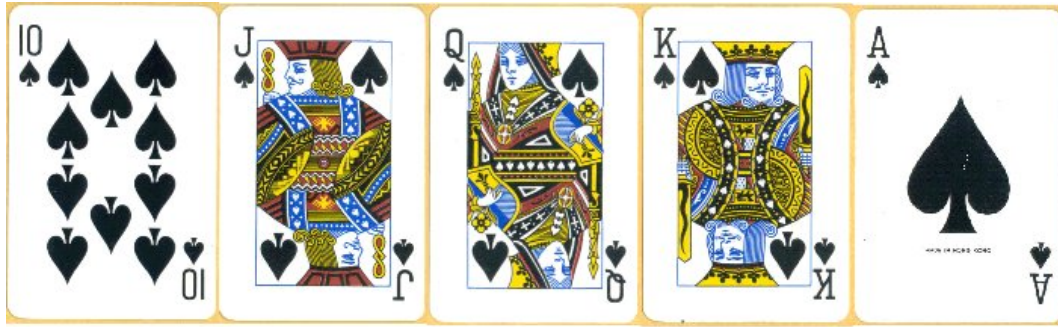


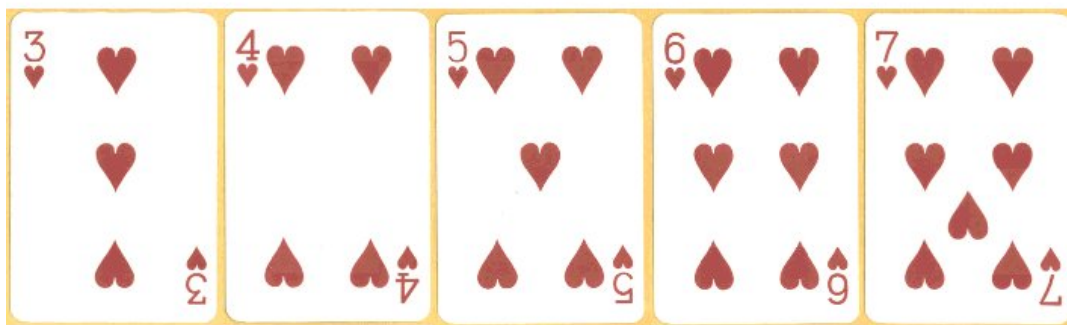
Poker – 5 Card Rush!

- Event: Cub Camp
Theme: America
Preparation Time: 15-20 minutes
Running Time: 20+ minutes
Materials: Playing Cards (Number of decks based on number of teams.
This game was designed for 3 teams of 6, using 3 decks)
Poker Hand Sheets
- Preparation: The main preparation involves creating the Poker Hand sheets, showing various hands and the points they are worth. These need to be printed out and attached to a table or similar. A designated Scorer will need to be stationed here. The playing cards are divided among a number of volunteers who are roaming the playing area (The Dealers).
- Playing The Game: Each team tries to score as many points as possible by creating poker hands within their teams (ideally 5 or more members in each). To do this they need to find the dealers who will give the Cub a card from the top of their 'deck'. A Cub can only hold one card at one time. If a Cub isn't satisfied with their card, they are able to exchange it, but can only do so with a different Dealer. Once a team has acquired a legal hand, they can then cash it in with the designated Scorer. Any cards handed in are then redistributed amongst the Dealers. Once a team has cashed in a hand, they can then go and obtain another hand, and keep doing so until Time is called.
- Notes: Unintentionally, this game highlighted which teams are truly working together. Although the Royal Flush is worth 100 points, if you have 6 Cubs going for 3 Aces of Spades, the chances of getting the points are slim (I won't go into in-depth probabilities!). Some teams were happy to collect multiple Pairs to rack up the points, but one team realised that the Flush was going to be the easiest to obtain and the most lucrative to repeat. All they needed to do was to choose a suit and ensure every member aimed for the same suit.



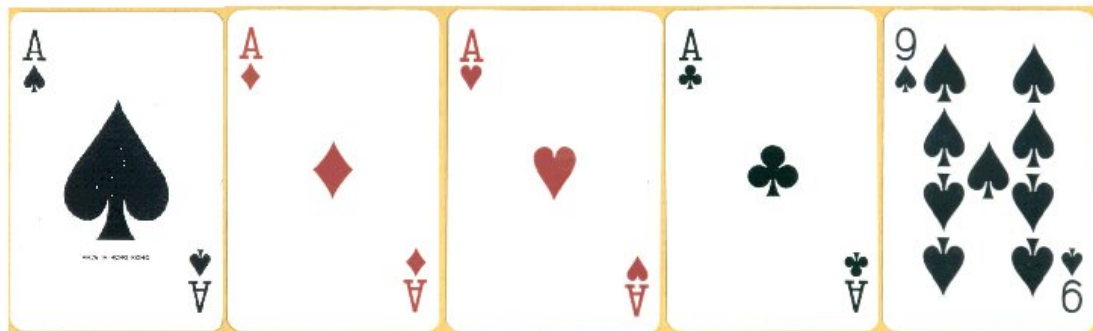
ROYAL FLUSH:
10, J, Q, K, A all the same suit

100 pts



STRAIGHT FLUSH:
5 consecutive cards, all the same suit

90 pts



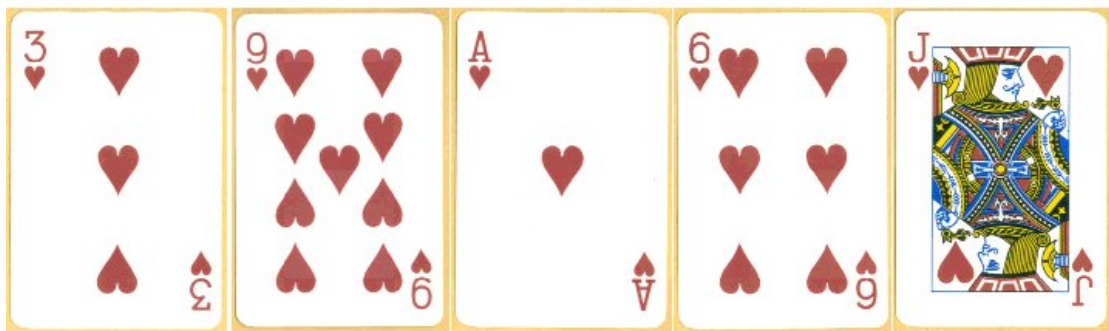
4 OF A KIND:
4 of one value card, plus one other

80 pts



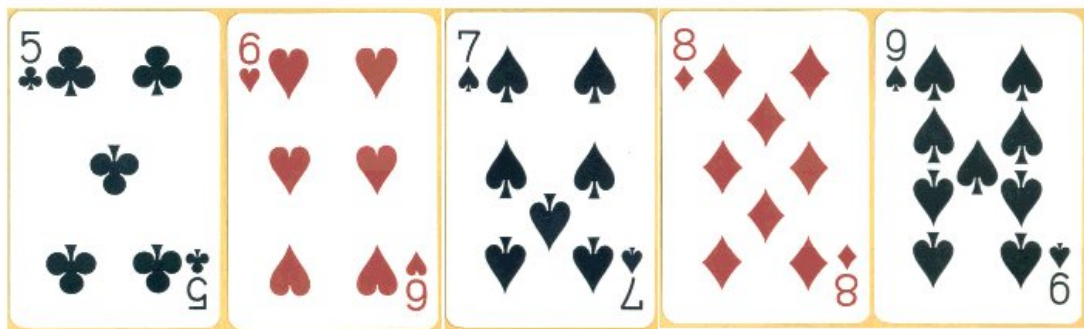
FULL HOUSE:
3 of one value card and 2 of another

70 pts



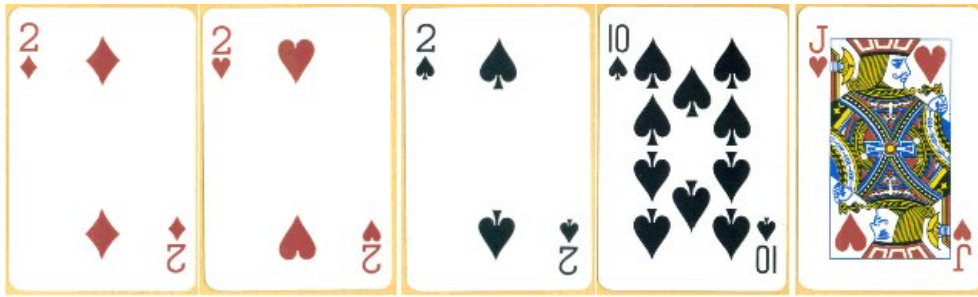
FLUSH:
5 cards, all the same suit

60 pts



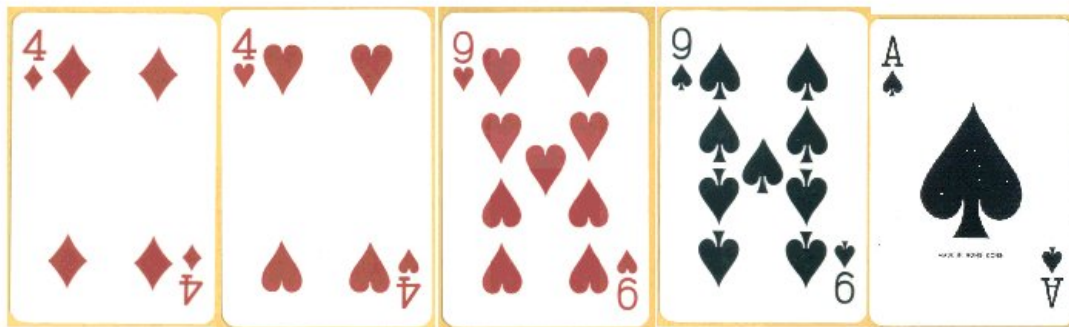
STRAIGHT:
5 consecutive values, all different suits
(doesn't have to be alternate colours!)

50 pts



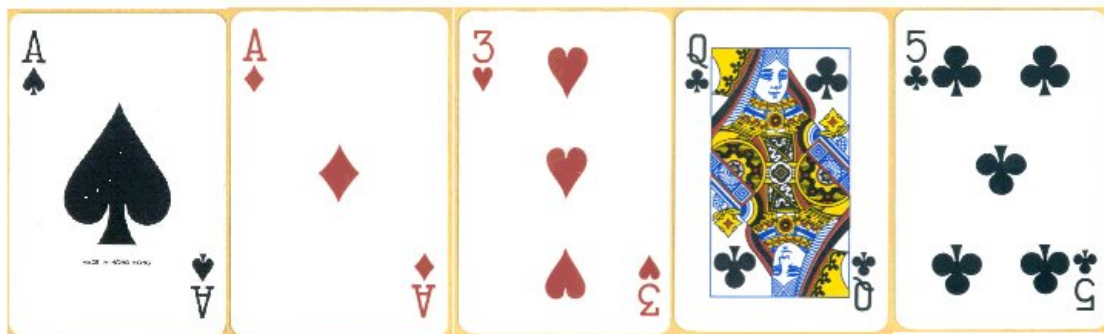
3 OF A KIND:
3 of one value card, plus 2 others

30 pts



TWO PAIRS:
2 of two different value cards, plus
one other

20 pts



ONE PAIR:
2 of one value card, plus three others

10 pts
