

Halloween Wide Game

Event: Cub/Beaver Joint Night
Theme: Halloween
Preparation Time: 1 hour
Running Time: 20-30 minutes
Materials: A form of “money” (The “pieces of silver” were pieces of eight made for a camp).
Coloured Paper, Marker Pens, Paints.
Golf Balls
Old CD and Case
Themed Sweets
Salt Sachets
Water/Flour/Oil/Red Food Colouring etc.
Spoons
Bowl
Specimen Vials or similar
1 Old Sock per Team
Sandwich Bags

Preparation: The golf balls are coloured to look like eyes, (they can be left white, the ones I used happened to be silver from a previous wide game, therefore “Silver Wolf”). The Pumpkins and Bat Wings are printed/drawn onto coloured paper and cut out. The Hearts and Frogs were extracted from the packets of sweets. The CD and case were designed as a music album. A blood mixture was made and put into the specimen vials. Each of the “Ingredients” were put into separate Sandwich Bags. The magic wand can be made out of black and white paper or just white paper rolled, then coloured. A “Recipe Card” needs to be created, as well as trade instructions for the Merchants.

Playing The Game: The merchants go out into the Woods with their wares. The teams are given a Recipe Card, the Cauldron a Spoon, a Magic Wand, 3 pieces of Silver and an old sock. They are then instructed that they have to help the local witch with her “Shopping”, and they may have to trade with the mysterious merchants of the woods. The Teams have to find the Merchants and trade items to collect all ingredients on the Recipe Card.



To complete the spell you will need
the following items and ingredients:

1 Cauldron

1 Spoon

Blood from a Stone

The Eyeball of a Silver Wolf

The Hearts of 3 Blind Mice

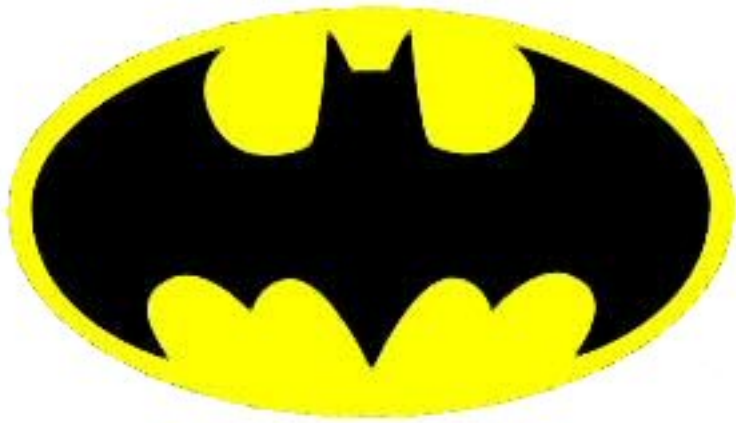
Heroic Bat Wings

5 Small Frogs

A Pinch of Salt

woods who may be able to help you...







Sell 1 Pumpkin for 1 piece of silver.

Sell 1 Eyeball for 1 piece of silver

Sell 1 CD for 1 piece of silver

Trade 3 Hearts for 1 CD

Trade 1 Bat Wings for 1 Sock

Trade 5 Frogs for 1 Magic Wand

Trade 1 Blood for 1 Pumpkin.

Trade Salt for Correct Knowledge:

1st Chance – Q. “What is a male witch called?”

A. “Warlock”

2nd Chance – Q. “What date is Halloween?”

A. “31st October”

3rd Chance – Q. “What is the colour of a witch’s cat?”

A. “Black”
